1.0 He Kōrero Whakatūwhera

Ko te tikanga o tēnei tuhinga kōrero he whakatakoto huarahi, he whakamārama hoki i ngā tino kaupapa a Te Kōmiti Whakahaere o Wairaikei¹. (Te Kōmiti)

This purpose of this document is to set the direction and outline the priorities for the Wairaikei Charitable Trust (the Trust).

Nō Mei, nō te 2007 i whakamanahia ai Te Kōmiti, i te hāinatanga o te Kaupapahere-ā-Kōmiti² e ngā mema o Ngā Hapū me Contact Energy Limited.

The Trust was formalised in May 2007 with the signing of the Trust Deed by representatives of Nga Hapu and Contact Energy Limited.

Ko te kaupapa matua a Te Kōmiti Whakahaere o Wairaikei he whakatakoto huarahi mō Ngā Hapū kia mau tonu ai tō rātou mana tīpuna ki runga i ō rātou wāhi tapu, ki runga hoki i ētahi o ā rātou taonga tuku kua pāngia ki ngā āhuatanga kino kua pūtake i ngā mahinga a ngā Whare Whakapūhikohiko Ngāwhā³ kei Wairaikei, kei Poihipi hoki.

The primary purpose of the Wairaikei Charitable Trust is to assist Nga Hapu in maintaining their ancestral connection to their waahi tapu and other taonga affected by the activities of the Wairaikei and Poihipi geothermal power stations.

Ko tā Te Kōmiti anō he whakamana, he whakakaha i te hononga i waenganui i Ngā Hapū rāua ko Contact Energy Limited, ka mutu, kua whakatūturuhia ki raro i te Kirimana-ā-Māramatanga⁴. Nō Hūrae, nō te 2003 i tohua ai e ngā rōpū.

The ancillary purpose of the Trust is to recognise and promote the partnership between Nga Hapu and Contact Energy Limited enshrined in the Memorandum of Understanding signed by the parties in July 2003.

2.0 Te Huarahi

2.1 Inanahi

Nō Contact Energy Limited ngā Whare Whakapūhikohiko Ngāwhā kei Wairaikei, kei Poihipi hoki, ōtirā, ko Contact Energy anō kei te whakahaere. Mahi rawa ai a Contact Energy Limited ki Te Papa Ngāwhā o Wairaikei – Tauhara⁵ hei whakapūhikohiko.

Contact Energy Limited owns and operates the Wairaikei and Poihipi geothermal power stations and is the primary users of the Wairaikei – Tauhara geothermal field for the purpose of electricity generation.

Nō Māehe, nō te 2001 i tonoa ai e Contact ētahi Whakaāetanga Rawa-ā-Taiao⁶ kia taea tonu ai ā rātou mahi whakapūhikohiko kei Wairaikei, kei Poihipi, kei Te Papa Ngāwhā o Wairaikei – Tauhara hoki te haere tonu atu kia 2026 rānō. (“Ngā Whakaāetanga 2001”).

In March 2001 Contact applied for a range of resource consents to permit the ongoing operation of the Wairaikei and Poihipi geothermal power stations and use of the Wairaikei – Tauhara geothermal field through to 2026 (“the 2001 Consents”).

Huhua noa atu ngā kōrero i tukuna atu ai e ngā hapū o Wairaikei hei whakatutuki i ngā take rawa-ā-taiao, i ngā take mō tō rātou ahurea, kia mārama ai te huarahi e tika ana hei mokowhiti, hei whakatika, hei whakangāwari rānei i ngā āhuatanga kino kua pūtake mai i ngā Whare Whakapūhikohiko⁷

Wairaikei hapu groups lodged a number of submissions seeking that the environmental and cultural effects of the power stations are appropriately avoided, remedied or mitigated.

Nō Hūrae, nō te 2003 i tohua ai tētahi Kirimana-ā-Māramatanga e ngā mema o ngā Kōmiti mō ngā rōpū mana whenua o Ngā Hapū, kei raro iho, rāua ko Contact Energy Limited, hei whakakaha anō i ngā hononga i waenganui i ngā rōpū nei. I runga i te pono, i te tika me te māramatanga. I whakapaehia, me whai whakaaro tonu te tangata ki ngā tikanga a tēnā, a tēnā, a tēnā. Kāti, anei ngā rōpū, (“Ngā Hapū”).

In July 2003 specific mana whenua hapu groups represented by the three signatory committees outlined below, and Contact Energy Limited, signed an overarching Memorandum of Understanding in which their desire to establish and maintain a long-term relationship based on mutual trust, openness and respect for each other’s needs and values was recorded. The signatory committees (“Nga Hapu”) comprise:

- Nō te 1991 i whakatūria ai Te Kōmiti Ture Whenua o Rauhoto⁸ i te hui-ā-hapū o Rauhoto, ā, i riro i ngā marae o Rauhoto, o Te Rangiita, o Maroa hei whakahaere i ngā take Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao⁹ a tō rātou ake rohe.

Rauhoto Land Rights Committee, which was established in 1991 at a Hui a Hapu of Rauhoto, Oruanui, Te Rangiita and Maroa Marae and which is mandated to deal with Resource Management issues within their Rohe.

- He tangata whenua a Ngāti Te Urunga nō runga i Ngā Tikanga Whenua a Rauhoto, nō runga hoki i te Ture Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao o Tauhara. Kua riro i Te Kōmiti o Ngāti Te Urunga hei whakahaere i ngā take mō ngā rawa-ā-taiao a tō rātou ake rohe.

Ngati Te Urunga have Tangata Whenua status within the Rauhoto Land Rights Rohe and the Tauhara RMA Rohe with the Ngati Te Urunga Committee Inc. mandated to deal with Resource Management issues within their Rohe.

- Kua riro mā Te Kapa o Te Rangiita Whenua Komiti Whenua Kōmiti me rāua ko Te Kōmiti o Oruanui marae hei wānanga i ngā take whenua, i ngā take Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao hoki e hāngai pū ana ki a Oruanui-a-Tia.

Te Kapa o Te Rangiita Whenua Komiti Whenua Komiti, a Hapu mandated Committee supported by the Oruanui Marae Trustees with the role of addressing land and Resource Management related issues of significance to Oruanui a Tia.

Nō Pepuere, nō te 2004 i tohua ai e Ngā Hapū rāua ko Contact Energy Limited tētahi Kirimana Whakaāe¹⁰ e mea mai ana kei te whakaāetia e ngā taha e rua te Whakaāetanga 2001 a Contact, ā, kei raro iho e whakamāramatia ana.

In January 2004 Nga Hapu and Contact Energy Limited signed a Heads of Agreement which outlined an agreed position regarding Contact's 2001 Consents as outlined below:

“Kei te tino aro atu a Contact ki te mana whenua me te kaitiakitanga o Ngā Hapū. Kei te tautokohia hokitia ngā tūāhuatanga o te Whakaāetanga Rawa-ā-Taiao kia tū tētahi tangata, nā Ngā Hapū anō i whakatū, hei mema ki runga i te Pōari Tātari Take o Wairaikei¹¹, hei huarahi whakamōhio hoki i ngā nekehanga mō Ngā Hapū”

“Contact acknowledges the mana whenua status and the kaitiakitanga role of Nga Hapu and will support resource consent conditions for an appropriately qualified

hapu-nominated representative to be on the Wairaikei Peer Review Panel and an appropriate feedback mechanism for Nga Hapu.

Nō runga i ngā tikanga mō te Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao e pupuri nei a Ngā Hapū, arā, (ko ngā wāhi tapu, ko ngā wāhi mahinga kai, ko ngā taonga, me te mauri hoki.). Kei te mōhiohia, nō te 1950 i tīmata ai te takahi i ēnei tikanga i Te Papa Ngāwhā o Wairaikei-Tauhara. Me te aha, e korekore rawa ēnei taonga tuku e rauora anō mai hei ngā tau itiiti kei te tū mai. Kei te mōhiohia hokitia me āta āwhina i a Ngā Hapū kia pakari tonu ai ō rātou herenga ki ō rātou wāhi tapu, ki ā rātou taonga tuku hoki kua pāngia ki ngā āhuatanga kino tonu kua pūtake mai i ngā mahinga whakapūhikohiko ki Te Papa Ngāwhā o Wairaikei-Tauhara. Heoi anō, kei te mōhiohia e haere tonu ake ana te pā kino mai o ngā āhuatanga kua pūtake mai i ngā Whare Whakapūhikohiko, engari, tē karo noa, e kore anō e rauora, nā konā me hui, me wānanga, me kōrero.”

In relation to the particular cultural and resource management values held by Nga Hapu (including waahi tapu, mahinga kai, taonga and mauri) it is recognised there have been adverse effects associated with the past utilisation of the Wairaikei-Tauhara geothermal system since the 1950s that can not be remedied and are effectively irreversible in the short to medium term. It is also recognised that there is a need to assist Nga Hapu in maintaining their relationship with their waahi tapu and other taonga affected by the utilisation of the Wairaikei Tauhara Geothermal System. As to their relationship, it is further recognised that there will be some ongoing adverse effects of future operations of the Power Plants that cannot be effectively avoided or remedied and need to be redressed.”

Nā konā, nā runga hoki i ngā take i huihuitia ai, kua whakatau a Ngā Hapū e kore anō rātou e whakahē atu ki te Whakaētanga 2001, i runga anō i te whakaaro me whai ara a Contact Energy Limited ki te whakatutuki i ētahi tonu o ngā tino take mō te Whakaētanga Rawa-ā-Taiao, ki te āta whakamātau hoki i ngā āhuatanga kino nei kua pā ki ngā wāhi tapu o Ngā Hapū, ka mutu, ka whakatakotoria tētahi huarahi hei whakangāwari ake i ēnei āhuatanga:

In light of these acknowledgments and as a consequence of the consultation undertaken, Nga Hapu agreed that they would not participate in opposition to the 2001 Consents on the basis that Contact Energy Limited would seek certain resource consent conditions, the investigation of subsidence effects in areas of special value to Nga Hapu and put in place the following mitigation package:

“Kei te whakaāe a Contact kia whakatakotoria tēnei Huarahi Whakangāwari¹² hei āwhina atu i a Ngā Hāpū kia mau tonu ai tō rātou mana tīpuna ki runga i ō rātou wāhi tapu me ētahi o ā rātou taonga tuku kua pāngia ki ngā mahinga a te Whakaāetanga Rawa-ā-Taiao 2001 mō Wairaikei. Kia whakamanahia, kia whakakahangia hoki te hono i waenganui i a Contact rātou ko ngā hapū o Wairaikei-Tauhara i raro i te Kirimana-ā-Māramatanga i tohua ai e ngā rōpū nei i te 1 July, i te 2003”.

“Contact agrees to provide the following Mitigation Package to assist Nga Hapu in maintaining their ancestral connection to their waahi tapu and other taonga affected by the activities consented pursuant to the Wairaikei 2001 resource consent applications, and also to recognise and promote the partnership between Contact and the Wairaikei-Tauhara Hapu Collective enshrined in the Memorandum of Understanding signed by the parties on 1 July 2003.

KARAHIPI

He akiaki, he whakangūngū i ngā uri a Ngā Hapū ki roto i ngā momo whare wānanga. Kia hāngai pū tonu te whai ki ngā kaupapa Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao (ehara i te mea koia noa iho). Ka hoatu a Contact i tētahi karahipi-ā-tau mō Wairaikei-Tauhara, ā, e \$2500 te rahi. Ia 5 tau, mai i tōna tīmatanga ka piki \$500 anō te rahi o te karahipi, ka whakaāetia ana, ka mau tonu ake te karahipi nei kia oti ai tā Contact Whakaāetanga Rawa-ā-Taiao ki Wairaikei, i tonoa ai i te 2001.

To encourage and upskill Nga Hapu members in tertiary education with special emphasis in (but not limited to) the area of natural resource management, Contact will make available an annual Wairaikei-Tauhara Hapu tertiary education scholarship of \$2,500. The scholarship amount shall escalate by \$500 per annum at the commencement of each fifth year anniversary from the date of this agreement, and the programme shall last for the duration of the Contact Wairaikei resource consents applied for in 2001, once they are granted.

PŪTEA WHAKANGĀWARI¹³

He tohatoha pūtea mō ngā kaupapa e hāngai pū ana ki ngā paearu e kōrerohia ana [kei Wāhanga 3.3 o te Kaupapahere-ā-Kōmiti], mai i te 2005 ki te otinga atu o te wāhi ki te Whakaāetanga, ka hoatu-ā-tau a Contact i te \$100,000 (“Te Utu-ā-tau”) mō te roanga atu o te Whakaāetanga Rawa-ā-Taiao a Contact ki Wairaikei¹⁴, ā, ka whakaāetia ana i raro i te Ture Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao 1991, ka utua tuatahitia, (kia kore ai e wāhirua, e whakaāe mai ana ngā rōpū nei, mehemea hei muri i te 2005 kē ka whakaāetia ai, ka hoki tonu atu te utu-ā-tau ki te 2005, mehemea rānei kīhei i

whakaāetia kua manakore ēnei whakaritenga). Ka rāwekehia-ā-tau te rahi o te utu hei whakarite atu ki ngā nekenekhehanga o Te Utu Kaihoko o Aotearoa¹⁵ (Rawa Katoa) Whakaraupapanga e tāngia ai e Tatauranga Aotearoa¹⁶ hei te hauwhā whakamutunga, i mua tonu i te tohatohatanga atu o te pūtea.

To provide an ongoing funding source for projects that meet the criteria outlined [in Clause 3.3 of the Trust Deed], from 2005 until the end of the consent period, Contact will make available on an annual basis a sum of \$100,000 (“The Annual Fund”) for the duration of the 2001 Contact Wairaikei resource consents with the first annual payment to be made when the consents are granted under the Resource Management Act 1991 (for the avoidance of doubt the parties agree that if the consents are granted after 2005 then the annual fund will be backdated to 2005 and if the consents are not granted this agreement will not be exercised). The sum will be adjusted annually to reflect the annual movement in the New Zealand Consumer Price (All Goods) Index published by Statistics New Zealand to the end of the latest quarter before the date of the disbursement of the funds.”

2.2 Te Kōmiti Whakahaere o Wairaikei

I whakatūria ai Te Kōmiti Whakahaere o Wairaikei hei whakahaere i ngā whakaritenga me te whai whakaaro anō kia ahu pēhea te Pūtea Whakangāwari.

The Wairaikei Charitable Trust was established to oversee the administration and provide direction for the content of the mitigation package.

Nō Mei, nō te 2007 i tohua ai e ngā kanohi o Ngā Hapū me Contact Energy Limited te Kaupapahere-ā-Kōmiti a Te Kōmiti Whakahaere o Wairaikei.

In May 2007 the Trust Deed of the Wairaikei Charitable Trust was signed by representatives of Nga Hapu and Contact Energy Limited.



Ko te tino kauapapa o Te Kōmiti Whakahaere o Wairaikei he whakatakoto huarahi mō Ngā Hapū kia mau tonu ai ō rātou mana tīpuna ki runga i ō rātou wāhi tapu, ki runga hoki i ētahi o ā rātou taonga tuku iho kua pāngia ki ngā āhuatanga kua pūtake i ngā Whare Whakapūhikohiko Ngāwhā kei Wairaikei, kei Poihipi hoki.

2.3 Apōpō – He whakatutuki whāinga

Ko ngā kaupapa matua a Te Kōmiti hei whai:

The activities of the Trust will focus on:

- Whanaungatanga – He whakakaha i te hono i waenganui i a Contact rāua ko Ngā Hapū.
Relationship – enhances and protects the relationship between Contact and Nga Hapu
- Kaitiakitanga – He whakarite huarahi mā Ngā Hapū hei whakapakari ki ngā mahi kaitiaki nō roto o Wairaikei-Tauhara.
Kaitiakitanga – enhance Nga Hapu’s kaitiaki role in the Wairaikei-Tauhara area.
- He hoatu pūtea mō te rangahau i ngā take o te taiao, mō ngā kaupapa Māori tonu hei whakatutuki i ngā whāinga e rua o runga ake.
Funding environmental and cultural projects that will assist in achieving the above two objectives.
- He Karahipi mā ngā uri a Ngā Hapū
Provide scholarship grants to Nga Hapu descendants
- He whakarite, he whakahaere hoki i ētahi kaupapa mātauranga hei akoranga mō Ngā Hapū.
Undertake activities to facilitate education programmes for Nga Hapu.

2.4 Ngā Ara – Ngā whakarite a Te Kōmiti

E 5 ngā manapou o Te Kōmiti hei whakatutuki i ngā whāinga.

There are five key mechanisms that the Trust will employ to achieve its objectives:

- Whanaungatanga – He whakakaha i te hononga i waenganui i a Contact rāua ko Ngā Hapū.
Relationship - enhance and protect the relationship between Contact and Nga Hapu

Ko tā Te Kōmiti he:

- Hanga i tētahi kāinga hiko ki te ipurangi hei whakaatu i ngā whakaritenga a Te Kōmiti, ō rātou whāinga, ā rātou whakahaerenga, ā rātou whakatutukinga anō hoki.
Develop a website to promote and showcase the activities of the Trust, including the objectives, governance and achievements.
- Hanga i tētahi pānui, nā Te Kōmiti ake mā ngā hapū, hei whakamōhiotanga mō ngā hua o Te Papa Ngāwhā o Karanga-Tauhara ka puta i ngā whakamātaumātau a Te Pōari Tātari Take.

Develop a Trust newsletter which will encompass a report back to hapu on the results of the Peer Review Panel assessment of Contact's operations on the Wairaikei- Tauhara Geothermal System.

- Whakatū Hui Motuhake-ā-Tau¹⁷ ki tēnā marae, ki tēnā marae o Ngā Hapū hei kauhau atu i ngā whakaritenga, i ngā whāinga hoki a Wairaikei. Ka nekeneke haere tēnei hui ki runga i ngā marae o Ngā Hapū.

Hold an annual AGM/ hui at which the activities of the Trust, as well as the activities and plans for Wairaikei, are presented. This AGM/hui is to be held at Nga hapu marae on a rotating basis.

- **Kaitiakitanga – He whakarite huarahi whakapakari mā Ngā Hapū ki ngā mahi kaitiaki nō roto o Wairaikei-Tauhara.**

Ko tā Te Kōmiti he:

- Hanga i tētahi “Huarahi whai mō ngā Kawa me ngā Tikanga Māori” mā Contact Energy (Ngāwhā¹⁸) hei whai mā Contact ki runga i ngā wāhi tapu o Ngā Hapū.

Development of a “Cultural Management Protocol” for Contact Energy (Geothermal) which will guide Contact's activities in areas of cultural significance to Nga Hapu

- Hanga i tētahi pānui, nā Te Kōmiti ake mā ngā hapū, hei whakamōhiotanga mō ngā hua ka puta i ngā whakamātaumātau a Te Pōari Tātari mō Te Papa Ngāwhā o Karanga-Tauhara

Develop a Trust newsletter which will encompass a report back to hapu on the results of the Peer Review Panel assessment of Contact's operations on the Wairaikei- Tauhara Geothermal System.

- He hoatu-ā-tau tētahi Karahipi ki te hunga e whakatinana ai i ngā painga motuhake mā Ngā Hapū nō roto i ngā mahinga kaitiaki whenua.

Provide annual education grants for individuals who will provide tangible benefits to Nga Hapu in exercising their kaitiaki role.

▪ **He hoatu pūtea mō ngā kaupapa taiao, mō ngā kaupapa Māori hoki**

Ko tā Te Kōmiti he:

- He hoatu pūtea, nā te Pūtea Kōmiti¹⁹ hei whakapakari i ngā kaupapa Māori pēnei i te whakapaipai marae, pēnei hoki i te hopuhopu i ngā kōrero tuku iho a ngā hapū.

Provide funding from the Trust fund for cultural enhancement projects such as Marae refurbishment and the recording of oral histories.

- He hoatu pūtea, nā te Pūtea Kōmiti, mō ngā kaupapa taiao pēnei i ngā momo rangahau kia whakarauora anō i te taiao.

Provide funding from the Trust fund for environmental projects such as research projects and environmental enhancements/ rehabilitation projects.

▪ **Hoatu Karahipi**

Ko tā Te Kōmiti he:

- He hoatu-ā-tau i tētahi Karahipi mō te hunga e whakatinana ai i ngā painga motuhake mā Ngā Hapū nō roto i ngā mahinga kaitiaki whenua.

Provide annual education grants for individuals who will provide tangible benefits to Nga Hapu in exercising their kaitiaki role.

▪ **He whakariterite huarahi hei akoranga mō Ngā Hapū.**

Ko tā Te Kōmiti he:

- Tautoko i tētahi kaupapa hanga rīpene whakaata e whakamāramahia ai te taonga nei ngā ngāwhā me tōna tikanga ake ki te Tangata Whenua, te whakatauwehenga atu hoki o te Tangata Whenua i Wairaikei, te whanaketanga mai o te hono i waenganui i a Contact Energy rāua ko Ngā Hapū.

Sponsor a project to develop a video outlining the cultural significance of the geothermal toanga to Tangata Whenua, the alienation of Tangata Whenua from Wairaikei and the development of the relationship between Contact Energy Limited and Nga Hapu.

3.0 Ngā Whakahaere

3.1 Ngā Hui

E 3 pea nuku atu ngā hui ka tū ia tau mā Te Kōmiti. Hui ai hei te:

The Trust will meet at least three times each year. Routine meetings will be held in:

- 1) Hānuere: Hei whakawhitinga kōrero mō ngā karahipi, mō ngā toenga kaupapa e tono pūtea mai ana.

January: to discuss scholarship applications and residual project funding applications.

- 2) Ākuhata: Hei whakawhitinga kōrero, hei whakatau hoki ka tohatoha pēhea te pūtea ki te nuinga o ngā kaupapa rangahau kua tono mai.

August: to discuss and decide on the majority of project funding applications

- 3) Hepitema: Hui Motuhake-ā-tau.

September: AGM and hui.

E taea hoki ana ngā hui motuhake te tono e tētahi tokorua noa iho o Te Kōmiti, i runga anō i te ohore.

Special meetings can be called at any time at the request of two of the Trustees.

3.2 Ngā Karahipi

Hei akiaki, hei whakangūngū i ngā uri o Ngā Hapū ki roto i ngā momo whare wānanga ka hoatu Te Kōmiti i tētahi karahipi-ā-tau mō ngā Hapū o Karanga-Tauhara, e \$2500 te rahi. (Ka piki-ā-tau te utu, kia hāngai pū tonu ki tā te Kaupapahere-ā-Kōmiti)

To encourage and up-skill Nga Hapu members in tertiary education the Trust will make available an annual Wairaikei-Tauhara Hapu tertiary education scholarship of \$2,500 (periodically escalated as detailed in the Trust deed).

Kei te wātea nga karahipi nei mā ngā tauira e kuraina ana ki tētahi o ngā momo whare wānanga, ā, me hāngai te whai ki tā te Whakahaere Rawa-ā-Taiao, engari, ehara i tēnei anake. Kia 2 kē ngā karahipi ka tohaina ia tau, ka mutu, kei ngā kaimahi o Te Kōmiti te tikanga e pēhea rā e tohatohaina ai ngā pūtea.

Me ‘Aotearoa’ mai te tangata ka tono karahipi mai, ā, me noho hoki ia i Aotearoa nei. Me 4 ngā whakatipuranga te aho whakaheke o tōna whakapapa ake nō roto mai o tētahi hapū o Ngā Hapū.

The scholarships are available to students studying at any registered tertiary institution with a special emphasis in, but not limited to, the area of natural resource management. There shall be up to two scholarship grants per year with the allocation of the available fund being at the discretion of the Trustees.

Applicants for scholarships must be New Zealand citizens and currently be living in New Zealand. Applicants must whakapapa to one of Nga Hapu for at least four generations.

Me whakatauirā mai, me āta whakamārama mai ngā kaitono he aha rā ngā painga o tāna e whai atu ai hei hua mō Ngā Hapū. Me whakatauirā mai ngā kaitono kei te hāngai ōna pūkenga hei whakatutuki i tāna i tono atu ai.

Applicants must be able to demonstrate / enunciate how their education will benefit Nga Hapu. Applicants must be able to demonstrate that they have the qualifications and capacity to undertake the proposed study.

Kei te wātea ngā karahipi mō ngā tauira kei ngā whare wānanga o waho kē atu o Aotearoa.

Scholarships are available for tertiary study outside of New Zealand.



Akene pea ka taea tētahi rangahau motuhake nei ki Contact Energy Limited Wairaikei Power Station e ngā kaitono karahipi, ōtirā kei Te Kōmiti te tikanga.

There is a possibility of an internship at Contact Energy Limited Wairaikei power station that may be considered for each scholarship applicant, subject to availability and at the discretion of the Trustees.

Ā te 15 o Pepuere ia tau Ka katia te tono karahipi mai.

Applications for scholarships close on February 15 every calendar year.

He pai atu kia utua tōtika te karahipi e Te Kōmiti ki te whare wānanga e tika ana.

It will be the preference of the Trust for payment of the scholarship to go directly to relevant tertiary institution.

3.3 Ngā Kaupapa Rangahau

He pūtea ā Te Kōmiti e wātea ana hei whakarite i ētahi kaupapa Māori, i ētahi kaupapa taiao hoki e hāngai ana ki tā te Kaupapahere-ā-Kōmiti.

Funding is available from the Trust to undertake cultural and environmental projects that meet the criteria outlined in the Trust Deed.

Ia tau, e 2 ngā wāhanga o te tau ka taea te tonu pūtea mai ki Te Kōmiti, ka katia tētahi wāhanga hei te 30 o Hūrae, ā, ka katia tētahi hei te 30 o Hānuere. E whakapaehia ana ka karangahia te nuinga o ngā tonu, (80% anake o te pūtea-ā-tau), mō te wāhanga ki te 30 o Hūrae. Ko ngā tonu āpiti anake ka whakaaroarohia e Te Kōmiti mō te wāhanga ki te 30 o Hānuere, (20% anake o te pūtea-ā-tau).

Applications for funding will be received by the Trust in two application rounds each year; one closing July 30, and one closing January 30. It is intended that the majority of applications (approximately 80% of annual funding) will be requested for the July 30 application round. Only supplementary applications will be received and reviewed by the Trust in the January 30 application round (approximately 20% of annual funding).

E 2 marama nuku atu i mua i ngā wāhanga tonu o te tau ka pānui atu, ka rapu hoki atu Te Kōmiti i ngā tononga mai (hei tauria, ā te Mei mō te wāhanga ki te 30 o Hūrae, ā te Noema mō te wāhanga o te 30 o Hānuere ia tau).

The Trust will advertise and actively seek applications for funding at least two months prior to the close of the application round (i.e. in May for the June 30 application round and November for the January 30 application round each year).

Ko ngā tonu e rahi ake ana te tonu i tā te Pūtea Kōmiti i whakarite-ā-tau ai (hei tauria, \$100,000) me whakaāe mai e Te Kōmiti, e te hapū anō hoki. He whakaāe noa iho nā Te Kōmiti mō ngā tonu iti iho i te \$100,000.

Applications that seek in excess of one years allocation of the Trust Fund (i.e.\$100,000) must be approved by the Trustees and receive hapu ratification. Applications of less than \$100,000 need only Trustees approval.

3.4 Whakawhitiwhiti Kōrero

Ka wātea ngā kōrero e pā ana ki ngā rangahau me ngā tono atu ki a Genesis Tuwharetoa Group rāua hoki ko Mighty River Power Tuwharetoa Group. Ka ngana atu ngā māngai o Te Kōmiti o Wairaikei kia hui tahi-ā-tau me ngā mema o tēnā Kōmiti, o tēnā Kōmiti.

The Trust will freely share information regarding projects and applications with the Contact Energy Group and the Mighty River Power Group. Representatives of the Wairaikei Trust will endeavour to meet with representatives of these other Trusts annually.

Ka whakahoua ai ngā pitopito kōrero o runga o te kāinga hiko a Te Kōmiti, ka whakamōhiohia anō ai ngā nekehanga, ngā kitenga matua hoki o ngā kaupapa rangahau kua whai pūtea mai i Te Kōmiti. Ko te tikanga, ka pānuihia ana ngā hua o ngā kaupapa rangahau kua whai pūtea mai, ka ngana anō ētahi atu kaupapa rangahau kia tono pūtea mai ki Te Kōmiti.

The Trust website will be regularly updated with the details and key milestones of those projects that receive funding from the Trust. It is envisaged that showcasing the outcomes of funded projects may encourage other potential projects to apply for funding from the Trust.
